

New text for the SC Rules of Procedure

Extract from the NAMMCO SC report 2014:

1. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

1.1. Number of SC members at meeting from each country

The SC **recommends** again that ROP should be amended to allow more than 3 members from each country at the meeting. Each country would still only have one vote.

Proposal by the NAMMCO SC for rewording of the ROP, item II on Membership:

Current wording:

II. Membership

1. Each Member Country shall nominate up to six scientists as members of the Scientific Committee with no more than three members present at any Scientific Committee meeting. The appointment is permanent or until the Member Country nominates new member(s) to the Committee. Each Member Country shall have one vote when procedural or organizational matters are being dealt with.

Revised wording:

II. Membership

1. Each Member Country shall nominate up to six scientists as members of the Scientific Committee. The appointment is permanent or until the Member Country nominates new member(s) to the Committee. Each Member Country shall have one vote when procedural or organizational matters are being dealt with.

The new revised text, as reviewed by the Committee for Finance and Administration, requires approval and adoption by Council.
